This thousands of years old talisman continues to fight against the evil eye all over the world.

In Turkey, wherever you look, you'll meet plenty of eyes looking at you; glass evil eye beads. It is common in the Turkish culture to give a gift of a blue Nazar Boncugu (or nazar boncuk) or the evil eye bead as it is more widely known by visitors to Turkey. People hang a small evil eye amulet from the rear view mirror of their car, keep several small evil eye beads or evil eye charms on hand to give to guests, hang an evil eye near their door in the home or office. Glass evil eyes are worn, in the form of jewellery; evil eye bracelet, evil eye necklace, evil eye anklet, gold or silver evil eye charms and evil eye pendant, evil eye earring. Here it is a real evil eye bead paradise.

According to common belief, the evil eye bead gives protection and brings luck to all. With its warm blue shine that it derives from the fire and the smiling face that's a feature of the Anatolian people, it gives happiness to family, friends and beloved ones

What is The Evil Eye

At almost every stage of human history, man has looked for the assistance of magic objects called talismans to defy evil forces. Evil eye charms with letters, numbers or abstract signs have survived to

this day. Even the modern religions with a single god have their own symbols on talismans. One of these symbols we find in almost every culture and faith for thousands of years... It's the figure of eye...



It was believed that, this eye saw all the wickedness in the world and removed poverty and ignorance. When Horus opened its eyes the world was enlightened, when he closed, it became dark. From Egypt, the eye talisman had spread to the Mediterranean, Middle East and Europe.

The blue evil eye beads of Turkey that have been smiling for thousands of years are eager to meet with the eyes of the new world. It is also known in most languages : In English as "bad eye", "the evil eye ", "evil look"- in French " Mauvais Oeil " - in German " böse Blick " - in Arabic "ayin hasad" (eye of envy) - Hungarian " szemmel veres" ("beating with eyes") - Polish "oko proroko" (" the eye of the prophet ") - Sicilian "jettatura" ("casting") . Brazilian Portuguese has "olho gordo" " ("fat eye") or "quebranto" "("breaker") - in Spanish " mal de ojo" (the eye's curse)- in Irish "droch-shuil" - in Greek " matiasma" or " mati "someone refers to the act of cursing someone with the evil eye.

Where to buy evil eye beads in Turkey?

The Covered Bazaar of Istanbul is one of the largest shopping centers on the world. Here, there are plenty of evil eye stores selling glass evil eye beads only. The eye bead and the objects with the eye bead figure attract great interest from the tourists. They also believe that it prevents bad luck and brings good luck. That's why they are so interested in glass eye beads and the objects that have this symbol.

The blue evil eye bead amulets are in a creative collaboration with the other decorative arts in Istanbul. To decorate something, the first item you think of is the evil eye beads or their figure. Either the eye beads decorate an object or they are decorated by some other objects.

THE GREAT SILK ROAD TOUR

The **Great Silk Road**, stretching all the way from **China** through **Central and West Asia** to **Europe**, is the greatest land-based trading highway the world has ever seen. From east to west, the main trade routes traversed China, Uzbekistan, Turkmenistan, Persia (Iran) and Turkey. With its numerous caravanserais and bazaars such as the Grand Bazaar in Istanbul, Turkey was an important distribution point to Europe. Most of the Silk Road routes went through and were controlled by Uzbekistan. This meant that the Silk Road trade brought untold riches and cities like **Bukhara, Samarkand** and **Khiva** flourished. Rulers of the time built some of the most opulent and impressive monuments and palaces.

They included exquisitely decorated **madrassas** (Islamic high education institutions), towering minarets, fascinating castles and colourful markets. Culture and science thrived alongside architecture. The notable names included **Omar Khayyam** (Poet), **Ibn Sina** (scientist) and **Timur** (ruler). The Uzbek cities evoke intrigue and mystery which we experience firsthand during our tour of this fascinating region.

RUSSIA/UKRAINE TOUR......



Highlights of the **Russia tour** included the iconic Moscow sites such as the *Red Square*, *St Basil's Cathedral* and the *Kremlin*. We also visit **Lenin's Mausoleum** and the impressive **Moscow Metro** system. We travel from Moscow to **St Petersburg** on the fast *Sapsan* train reaching speeds of over 250kms per hour.

Founded by Peter the Great in 1703, St Petersburg more than deserves the title "**Venice of the North**". With its fabulous architecture, vibrant and life filled streets, ritzy cafes and restaurants and charming canals, St Petersburg is undoubtedly one of the best cities in the world.

Amongst its numerous palaces, the Catherine Palace in Pushkin is probably the most elegant. Designed by the Italian architect Rastrelli, it is a real master piece. With its dazzling fountains, the Petergof Palace is also a must see in St Peterburg.

Isfahan with its rich Persian and Islamic architecture is the

jewel in Iran's tourism crown. Here we visit the vast, world famous *Naqsh-e Jahan* square complex including the *Imam Mosque*, the *Sheikh Lotfullah Mosque* and *Ali Qapu* Palace. We also visit the *Forty Column Palace* and the magnificent historical bridges over the River Zayandeh.

ALLURE OF AZERBAIJAN (7 Days / 6 Nights)

Azerbaijan is an enigma; it is an incredible tangle of contradictions and contrasts. The nation's cosmopolitan capital **Baku** is a dynamic boomtown where flashy limousines and mushrooming skyscrapers sweep around a picturesque UNESCO-listed old city. Yet only a few hours' drive away lies an entirely different world of timeless villages in the foothills of the soaring high Caucasus mountains.

On this tour, we will see attractions of contrasts in a country of contrasts. In Baku, we visit historic caravanserais, mosques, the palace of the **Shirvanshahs**, a carpet museum and the walled medieval city of "*Icheri Sheher*" with its narrow alleyways. We take an excursion to the **Absheron Peninsula**, visiting the *Zoroastrian Fire Temple* and **Yanardagh** (Burning Mountain) and **Gobustan** with its ancient petroglyphes.

In the Caucasus Mountains, where the dry landscape around Baku gives way to a densely forested mountain area, we visit the fascinating towns and villages. Here we see the *Juma Mosque; Yeddi Gumbez*, the oldest church in the Caucasus dating from the first century; the Royal Summer Palace of the *Sheki Khans* with its magnificent frescoes and stained glass and **Sheki Museum and Fortress**. We stay in a beautifully restored Caravansary Hotel.
